WEDDING: The couple (**not parents**) must make the first contact with the parish office **6 months** in advance before setting a date and making **any** wedding plans or arrangements. A Wedding Preparation Program **must** be taken at **Catholic Family Services** (306-525-0521) or through **Catholic Engaged Encounter** (306-586-0934). Confer with the Pastor to ensure that songs you choose for your Catholic wedding are liturgically appropriate.

Holy Week Schedule

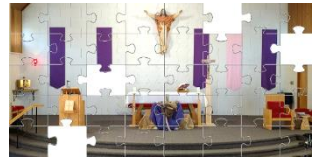
Tuesday, Apr. 16: Mass at 6:00 p.m. **Good Friday**, Apr. 19: Service at 3:00 p.m.
