BAPTISM: For babies and young children: After most weekend Masses except the fourth Saturday of the month. You must fill out an application form (available online) well in advance. There is a **mandatory** Baptism class for parents and godparents, who must be practicing Catholics. Please call to make arrangements. **For children turning seven and older, teens and adults**, RCIC or RCIA classes are required. Please call for details.

WEDDING: The couple (**not parents**) must make the first contact with the parish office **6 months** in advance before setting a date and making **any** wedding plans or arrangements. A Wedding Preparation Program **must** be taken at **Catholic Family Services** (306-525-0521) or through **Catholic Engaged Encounter** (306-586-0934). Confer with the Pastor to ensure that songs you choose for your Catholic wedding are liturgically appropriate.


Last week's collection for our parish was \$4092.05. May God reward you and bless you.

Suggestions for National Week for Life and the Family, May 12-19 (from cccb.ca)

- Prepare a special meal together as a family. Take some extra time during grace to have each member of the family affirm another member of the family.
- Pray a scriptural rosary together. If you have small children, pray only one or two decades. A scriptural rosary is available at www.kofc.org/en/resources/cis/cis319.pdf.
- After supper on Saturday evening, go over the readings for the Mass on Sunday.
- If you have a young child or children, buy them a children's Bible or a Bible coloring book. If you have teenagers, the following apps are available free: Laudate, The Catholic Mega App, Rediscover: app, Catholic Study Bible App, The Pope App.
- Make a family pilgrimage to a special shrine or church, or "tour" St. Peter's Basilica at Youtube.
- Read the Gospel of Mark together. It is the shortest gospel, and takes about one and a half hours to read; read it over the course of one week (~13 minutes a day).

From Pope Francis' Message for the World Day of Prayer for Vocations

God in fact desires that our lives not become banal and predictable, imprisoned by daily routine, or unresponsive before decisions that could give it meaning. The Lord does not want us to live from day to day thinking that nothing is worth fighting for, slowly losing our desire to set out on new and exciting paths. If at times he makes us experience a "miraculous catch", it is because he wants us to discover that each of us is called – in a variety of ways – to something grand, and that our lives should not grow entangled in the nets of an ennui that dulls the heart. Every vocation is a summons not to stand on the shore, nets in hand, but to follow Jesus on the path he has marked out for us, for our own happiness and for the good of those around us. Embracing this promise naturally demands the courage to risk making a decision. The first disciples, called by Jesus to be part of something greater, "immediately left their nets and followed him" (Mk 1:18).
