BAPTISM: For babies and young children: After most weekend Masses except the fourth Saturday of the month. You must fill out an application form (available online) well in advance. There is a **mandatory** Baptism class for parents and godparents, who must be practicing Catholics. Please call to make arrangements. **For children turning seven and older, teens and adults,** RCIC or RCIA classes are required. Please call for details.

WEDDING: The couple (**not parents**) must make the first contact with the parish office **6 months** in advance before setting a date and making **any** wedding plans or arrangements. A Wedding Preparation Program **must** be taken at **Catholic Family Services** (306-525-0521) or through **Catholic Engaged Encounter** (306-586-0934). Confer with the Pastor to ensure that songs you choose for your Catholic wedding are liturgically appropriate.

Finding the Church in Genesis 1 (St. Augustine, Confessions, XIII: 1,4,5,10,25)

I call upon you, my God, my mercy (Ps. 58:18)...Among the first acts of creation You said, "Let there be light, and light was created" (Gen. 1:3). I do not think it out of harmony with the sense if we take this to mean the spiritual creation...You made it not because You needed it, but from the fullness of Your goodness. "Your good Spirit" (Ps. 142:10) "was borne above the waters" (Gen. 1:2)...When scripture says Your Spirit rests on people (Isa. 11:2), it means that the Spirit makes them rest on Himself... "Love is diffused in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who is given to us" (Rom. 5:5)...Lit by Your fire, Your good fire, we grow red-hot and ascend...It is as if God says, "Let there be lights in the firmament of heaven," and suddenly "suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as if a vehement wind blew, and tongues of fire were seen split, which rested on each of them" (Acts 2:2-3). And the lights, made in the firmament of heaven, have the Word of life (Phil. 2:15-16). Run everywhere, holy fires, fires of beauty. Do not be under a bushel basket (Matt. 5:14-15). He to whom you have adhered is exalted...Run and make it known to all nations. (Henry Chadwick's translation, adapted.)


CWL Angel Tree for Father's day Mass


