A Wedding Preparation Program **must** be taken at **Catholic Family Services** (306-525-0521) or through **Catholic Engaged Encounter** (306-586-0934). Confer with the Pastor to ensure that songs you choose for your Catholic wedding are liturgically appropriate.
